



Application Instructions

- Please complete the application form using your own words. You can do it online or in print. Try to use a computer, as handwriting is often hard to read. If you do not have a computer, please make sure you print legibly in black ink. You may add additional pages if needed.
- Please list the name and contact information (phone number and email) of **at least one reference** (more is better). A reference could be just about anyone -- a teacher, coach, counselor, employer, or personal friend (adult) – except a family member. Reference forms are kept confidential and should be sent directly to Mālama Learning Center.
- Your application and reference forms are **due on February 24, 2017**. Please send to chelsey@malamalearningcenter.org or mail to PO BOX 75467, Kapolei, HI 96707.
- You will be notified by **March 4, 2017** on whether or not you are selected for this program.
- If you are selected, please be sure to reserve the following dates: **March 20-24, 2017** from 8am-3pm. A three-day overnight camp at Camp Pālehua (former Camp Timberline) in Makakilo will take place on 3/21-3/23. A detailed itinerary and instructions for the week will be sent to you upon notification of your acceptance into this program.
- If you are accepted into the program, you will be required to pay a non-refundable program fee of **\$25** to reserve your space. If this fee is a hardship on your family, please ask us about partial scholarships. Please note that the true cost of this program is approximately \$500/student and it is largely subsidized by a grant from the NOAA B-WET program.
